Mother and Child Health

1. pregnancy, giving birth, parenting

1) Delivery of Your Mother and Child Health Handbook

△ Application place. After an interview in the Mother and Child Health Division (inside Health Care Center), you can request the Birth Delivery Support benefit (50,000 yen).

*If you cannot come at office in weekdays (from 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.) due to your work, please contact us.

*Do a reservation through the applicative "Raku-Raku ★ Easy Immunization Navi" or by telephone.

2) Infant family visitation project

Home visitation will be made for families who have 2 to 3 months old baby to give an information about parenting. Subject for everyone.

After the interview, you can request the Child care support benefit (50,000 yen).

3) Babe square for 4 months old

Families who have age of about 4 months, old baby can get instruction about physical information, confirmation of development, child-care consultation, and parenting. The place will be the Health Center. The day and time will be informed individually, Everyone is eligible.

4) If you have any problem or worry about pregnancy, giving birth, or parenting,

Health supporter, nutritionist, odontologist and midwife can give advice by telephone or visit at home. Please consult with the Maternal and Child Health Division.

2. Medical Checkups

1) For expectant mothers

• Health checkups

By the separate volume of the Maternal and Child Health Handbook (Pregnancy Health Checkup Slip), consult one of the Prefecture Medical Institutions.

For checkups outside Chiba Prefecture, please consult with the **Maternal and Child Health Division** beforehand.

• Dental health checkups

The consultation ticket is also given together with Maternal and Child Health Handbook.

This voucher entitles you to one dental checkup while pregnant at one of the city's approved medical institutions. The fee is \mathbb{\pm}400. (Note: This fee is waived for recipients of public assistance for everyday living.)

•New born hearing test

According the Mother Child Health Handbook, until 50 days after child birth in any medical institution in the Prefecture.

2) Newborn child

• Newborn medical examination

You can do it at a city hall registered medical institution in the prefecture, within 50 days after birth, using the separate volume of the Maternal and Child Health Handbook (newborn hearing screening test consultation slip).

Before that, consult the Mother and Child Health Section.

3) For infants

• Health checkups (between three and six months and nine and eleven months) By the separate volume of the Maternal and Child Health Handbook (Infant Health Checkup Slip), consult one of the Prefecture Medical Institutions. For checkups outside Chiba Prefecture, please consult with the Maternal and Child Health Division beforehand.

4) For toddlers

- Health and dental checkups
- ♦ Health Checkups for 18-Month-Olds (from a year and a half to less than two years old)

Individual notification. Please, consult a medical institution.

♦ Dental Checkups for 18-Month-Olds (from one year and ten months to one year and eleven months old)

Individual notification. Medical consultation for groups is done in the Health Care Center.

♦ Dental Checkups for 2-and-a-Half-Year-Olds (two and a half years old); application basis

Note: Schedule to be announced through public bulletin, etc.

♦ Health Checkups for 3-Year-Olds (from three years and four months to less than four years old)

Individual notification. Please, consult a medical institution.
